VOLUNTEER ENROLLMENT INFO

Volunteers must complete the enrollment paperwork as well as complete the below requirements.

Background Checks

All volunteers must undergo a background check before working with our 4-H youth. Background checks are good for 5 years once completed. All volunteers, please check your status in your Zsuite account.

Contact Aesa at the Extension Office if your volunteer status does not show as "approved."

Mandatory Training

Volunteer must also complete the "Working with Minors Training" through Zsuite <u>every year</u>,. This helps ensure our youths' safety and keeps insurance costs down. This training can be found under the "Clover Academy," on the menu in your Zsuite account, once your enrollment (including background check - due every 3 years) is complete.



Coaches Corner UPDATE VOLUNTEER ENROLLMENT


All club and project leaders/coaches/volunteers MUST update their enrollment for the 4-H year annually.
