

Scholarship Requirements

- Member of a Guadalupe County 4-H Club

- Must be seeking a higher education through an accredited college or vocational institution.

Enrollment must be renewed annually <u>by all members-</u> <u>new & returning</u> with the start of the new 4-H year every October.

To renew your enrollment, follow these easy steps:

- 1. Log into your ZSuite account.
- 2. Look over the information that's been input about you in years past (for example, your address, your emergency contact etc.) Make sure it is all correct and up to date; please update as necessary and add new information.
- Download the prompted waivers, fill out the necessary information, sign and date the bottom.
 When completed, reupload the waivers into ZSuite.
- 4. Pick your club and whatever projects you may be interested in for the upcoming year!
- 5. Call the Extension Office at 575-472-3652 if you need help!

ZSuite Trainings:

Your ZSuite account offers several trainings that are beneficial to volunteer leaders and parents. They may benefit youth club leaders, as well. Volunteers are required to complete a few of the following trainings:

NEW MEXICO WORKING WITH MINORS TRAINING: This training is mandatory for all volunteers & leaders.

The "Working with Minors" training on ZSuite covers policies, reporting procedures, creating a safe environment, and handling emergencies.

New Mexico Working Finance Training:

This training is beneficial for club treasurers and other officers.

The financial training on ZSuite covers budgeting, financial reporting, managing funds, and understanding financial policies. It also includes procedures for handling donations, tracking expenses, and ensuring financial transparency and accountability.

•••••••4-H VOLUNTEER TRAINING COURSE:

This training is beneficial for volunteers, members and leaders. The 4-H Volunteer training course on ZSuite covers the organization's mission and values, volunteer roles and responsibilities, safety protocols, and effective communication with youth. It also includes strategies for creating engaging and educational activities, understanding youth development, and fostering an inclusive environment.

This training is beneficial for volunteers, members and leaders.

The NM 4-H 101 training on ZSuite covers the basics of 4-H, including its history, mission, and structure. It also explains the roles and responsibilities of members and volunteers, as well as the programs and activities available. Additionally, it includes guidelines for creating a safe and inclusive environment for all participants.

UPDATE VOLUNTEER ENROLLMENT

All club and project leaders/coaches/volunteers MUST update their enrollment for the 4-H year annually. Background checks do not have to be renewed annually, but every 5

Background Checks 🦊

All volunteers must undergo a background check before working with our 4-H youth. Background checks are good for 5 years once completed. All volunteers, please check your status in your Zsuite account. Contact Aesa at the Extension Office if your volunteer status does not show as "approved."

Mandatory Training

Volunteer must also complete the "Working with Minors Training" through Zsuite <u>every year</u>,. This helps ensure our youths' safety and keeps insurance costs down. This training can be found under the "Clover Academy," on the menu in your Zsuite account, once your enrollment (including background check due every 3 years) is complete

Please make sure to sign up on the Remind app if you are not already! Through this app we are better able to communicate with parents and members important information.
